

# The Chapel

Nestled among our 227 acres of vines, and tucked into a lush grove of trees, the Chapel features checkerboard gray and white marble floors, leaded glass windows, and a hand-painted mural ceiling featuring "The Story of Virginia" by internationally renowned artist Graham Rust.

The interior detail of the pews, altar, altar rails, lectern, and chairs were all copied from Shobdon Chapel, an English chapel in Wales.

The long aisle is flanked by ornate wooden pews and surrounded by floor-to-ceiling windows with beautiful views. The loft houses an 1805 Longman and Herron pipe organ and is the perfect place for a harpist, string quartet, or pianist to accompany a ceremony.

The Chapel was built to be interfaith. Use of the Chapel is included in your rental fee of the Barn & Pavilion or Grand Hall and is subject to availability.
